EAGLE MOUNTAIN PROJECT



Surerus Murphy Joint Venture is constructing the pipeline portion of ForticBC's Eagle Mountain to Woodfibre gas pipeline. The pipeline will lead to Woodfibre's Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) terminal near Squamish, B.C. and will play a role in meeting the rising demand for LNG as an environmentally friendly fuel option. This pipeline will run between Coquitlam and Squamish, B.C. and is twinned along most of its route to minimize environmental impacts.

Upon completion, the pipeline will increase FortisBC's capacity to transport natural gas to the Woodfibre LNG Facility safely. It will also play a role in meeting the rising demand for LNG as a more environmentally friendly fuel option for marine shipping and international use.

- Open cut crossings: 242 watercourses, 34 wetlands, 10 roads, 30 pipelines
- **Steep slopes:** 5 steep forward slopes over 20 degree (1,400m) and numerous steep side slope segments (totalling 11,000m)
- Hydrotest sections: 9 mainline and 3 facility sites
- Welds: 2.500 welds
- Welding processes used: semi-mechanized welding SMAW/FCAW and conventional SMAW
- Coating processes used: brush applied two-part epoxy


